VENDOR GUIDELINES

Application Deadline –

Categories Accepted – Nurseries, garden supplies, lawn maintenance, flowers, plants, shrubbery, garden décor, garden buildings, garden tools,

Acceptability Guidelines – All items must be listed on application and be pre-approved by show director. Shared booths are available.

Show Promotion – SF&G will be promoted in the following: The Crossville Chronicle, Facebook, CCMGA website, posters in store fronts, flyers, signs and banners in and around Crossville.

Space Info - spaces are 10' x 10' in Buildings 1, 1-A and 3. Spaces in Bldg. 4 are 14' x 10', Outside spaces are 25' x 50'. Decoration of spaces must be completed by 2 hours prior to opening on Friday and you must occupy the space until the show closes on Saturday at 5:00. No early take-down.

Chairs & Tables – Chairs and tables are provided at no additional expense, up to a maximum of 3 tables per booth. Linen tablecloths are provided for indoor booths only. You may put plastic tablecloths on outdoor booths. Do not put plants directly on linen tablecloths.

Electricity – Electricity is provided free of charge to all indoor booths. There is electrical for outside booths and can be run to Building #4. Free Wi-Fi is available in Bldg. 1.

Prohibited Items – No pets (service animals only). No unattended children, firearms, alcoholic beverages, or political items.

Security – The Complex is locked at night and all possible measures are taken to insure security of your products.

Cancellations – Refunds available until April 1st. Partial refund up to April 15th. No refunds after that date.
